

## QF 8017 – INSTRUCTIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL PURCHASE ORDERS

*Persons outside of USA must follow all instructions below when shipping to Teledyne Storm Products.*

The commercial invoice must contain the following information in English language:

1. Part number
2. Description of item
3. Purchase order number
4. Country of origin
5. Full value of goods in US dollars – this should be the actual selling value of the goods - do not use \$0.00

### Shipment / carrier requirements

1. Ship FedEx using the expanded service international air waybill
2. Complete section 6 – **broker select must** be checked
3. Identify U.S. customs broker as:

### Country of Origin Marking Requirements

U.S. Customs laws (19 CFR 134) require that every article of foreign origin (or its container) imported into the United States must be marked “Made in (add country of origin)” in a conspicuous place as legibly, indelibly and permanently as the nature of the article permits. If a part cannot be marked, then the part’s container must be marked “Made in (add country of origin)”. This container **IS NOT** the outer shipping container.

### At time of shipment

Place a copy of the commercial invoice on the outside of the carton.
